



## **Youth Exchange: European History and Remembrance -Remembering the Roma Genocide during WWII!**

23.11-30.11.2019, Berlin - Germany

### **Project description**

This international creative and awareness-raising youth exchange creates a space of sharing knowledge, raising awareness and creativity for 36 young Roma and non-Roma from 6 European countries (Germany, Macedonia, Romania, Lithuania, Bulgaria and Serbia) with a special focus to strengthen the understanding of the Roma genocide during WW II among Roma and non-Roma youth in Europe and the Balkans. During 6 days the young people will create their own stories and visions of empowerment and understandings based on their own experiences of discrimination and social inclusion and through a wide range of creative and artistic actions and work together as a team. The project beside raising awareness about the Roma genocide during WWII through creative methods, aims to strengthen the intercultural dialogue between Roma and non-Roma youth, as well as to support the long-term cooperation and exchange between Roma and non-Roma Youth organizations.

### **Facts**

**Dates (including travel days):** 23.11-30.11.2019

**Country:** Germany

**Location:** Berlin, Hotel location will be shared additionally

**Costs of participants:** Travel costs reimbursement according to Erasmus plus rules and distance calculator; Accommodation, food and activity costs are covered by the host organization.

**Note:** The project started officially on the 1-st of September 2019! All costs related to the project are eligible after this date.

**Reimbursement is done:** Via bank transfer. To be eligible to receive the reimbursement you will need to provide all original boarding passes, invoices, return tickets etc. on the spot during the first days of the project or via email. The reimbursement is done via bank transfer to the sending organization (to avoid the high bank costs for each participant separately) in maximum 30 days after receiving all original invoices and return tickets. Please, note that the bank costs are not eligible for coverage through this project.

**Arriving earlier to the exchange:** You can arrive max. 24 h before the exchange and leave 24 h later! But, please send an e-mail to: [merdjan@amaroforo.de](mailto:merdjan@amaroforo.de), explaining the reason why you travel earlier. Arriving earlier means that we only cover the travel costs, accommodation and food needs to be covered by yourself for those extra days.

But, we are keeping the age of 30 below 20% on the actual YE! Each participant is responsible for their own travel insurance. For this project, there is no participation fee! For the group leader, no age limit!
