



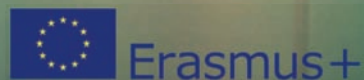

WHAT IS THIS YOUTH EXCHANGE ABOUT?

"Tolerance bring Harmony" is a youth exchange that brings 54 young people together from Macedonia, Germany, Greece, Italy, Czech Republic and Romania.

The aim of our project is to motivate and actively involve discriminated young people in volunteer activities, promoting tolerance through theater, music and dance, reducing discriminatory attitudes and increasing inclusion in their communities.





OBJECTIVES

With this project, we would like to reach the following objectives:

- * To stimulate the motivation of the participating Roma and non-Roma young people to be actively engaged in voluntary activities promoting tolerance.
- * To improve the knowledge of the participants on the contribution of volunteering and active citizenship to reducing discriminatory attitudes in partner local communities.
- * To develop the skills and competencies of the participants to initiate, organize, and conduct volunteer activities that promote tolerance through theater, music and dance.
- * To promote the tolerance through theater, dance and music of the participating young people.

THE VENUE



The venue of the project is Milcoveni village, Caras-Severin County. Participants will be accommodated internationally mixed in rooms of 4-6 people in with own bathroom.

There is an equipped training room, an event tent for activities, leisure space, a restaurant, where 3 meals and 2 coffee breaks will be served a day.

TRAVEL

The nearest airport/ bus / or train station is **Timisoara**, but other options are **Belgrade** and **Budapest**.

From these points we will arrange pick-up by mini buses, as the venue is located in a small village without public transport connection. .



COSTS

TRAVEL BUDGET

North Macedonia 180€/pers.

Germany 275€/pers.

Please, note, that for the pick-up we contract with a local travel agency that charges the following costs from the travel budget:

Timisoara-Milcoveni-Timisoara 40€/pers.

Belgrade-Milcoveni-Belgrade 60€/pers.

Budapest-Milcoveni-Budapest 75€/pers.

Travel costs for the program will be reimbursed after all the invoices, e-tickets, boarding passes and other necessary documents are delivered to the partner NGO according to Erasmus + rules.

Accommodation, food and materials during activity days are fully covered by Erasmus+ Programme.

There is no participation fee.



USEFUL INFO

CURRENCY

In Romania the currency is RON, we do not use Euro. The exchange rate is around 1 EUR = 4.75 RON.

Please be aware, that Milcoveni is a small village **without** ATM or money exchange office, and in the local shops you can pay **by cash only**.

WEATHER

Middle of September is very changeable in Romania. Sun and rain can be changed day by day. We expect 15-25 degrees during the days, and 5-10 degrees in nights. Check the weather forecast before leaving and prepare your clothes accordingly.

HEALTH INSURANCE

To have EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) or other type of health insurance is mandatory for all participants.

MEALS

Please keep in mind, that in the camp the 3 meals served a day will be based on traditional Romanian cuisine (combined with international meals), that might be different from your traditional food.

We provide meals according to your diet if necessary.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU?

- European Health Insurance Card (and ID card, of course)
- Towel and slippers
- Comfy clothes according to the weather
- Medicines according to your health and needs
- Personal hygiene supplies
- Food and national specialities for the international evening
